Food for Life Ukraine: Please donate

A severe food shortage is eminent over the Christmas period: Please help

Dear Justine,

Since the escalation of the war in Ukraine on 24th February 2022, the UN estimates that 3.6 million people have been displaced within the country or have fled abroad. Millions of families have been left without a home, food, essentials such as water and electricity, safety, and security. Many have found it difficult to feed themselves and their families, putting themselves at risk of starvation and disease.

You may have seen the destruction caused to infrastructure by the constant missile bombings in the Luhansk and Donbass regions in eastern Ukraine. People are risking their lives stepping outside of basements where they are sheltering in order to find food and water.

Food for Life

Food for Life is a voluntary organisation actively helping those displaced by the crisis in Ukraine. We provide hot vegan meals, medical supplies, and PPE. Every donation is passed onto our volunteers directly working in Ukraine.

- We prepare and distribute 11,000 hot meals on a daily basis
- We have 400 volunteers across our country preparing and distributing hot meals every day

To feed those in need on an everyday basis we need to buy groceries on a continual basis, pay utility bills and keep running our Food for Life transport vans so we can deliver hot meals to those not able to visit our kitchens such as those who are disabled and the elderly.

Olesya's story

“I started to volunteer for Food for Life back in 2014 when our region was occupied by the Russian forces. I was very depressed by the whole situation, lack of food in

shops, running water only 3 times a week. I was a teacher before the occupation and lost many students as a result of the aggression. Some of my friends died, my sister became internally displaced when she left the region with her family. I can't even see my mother because it is too dangerous for her to leave her home.

I saw there were many people with bigger problems than mine, people who had lost limbs due to mines, lonely, elderly people whose families had fled. I decided to sign up with Food for Life and never looked back. I enjoy delivering hot meals to the elderly and disabled. They are always so happy to see me and me too. My work is so important.

Since the escalation of the war this year, it was difficult and dangerous to get out and continue working, but I managed and now we are providing food for those displaced in our regions. It's really terrible, but by helping others, it keeps me going".
